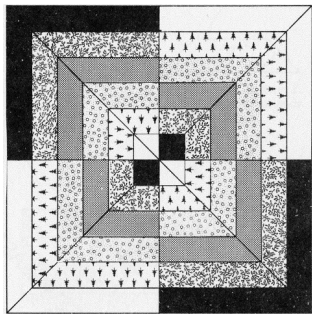

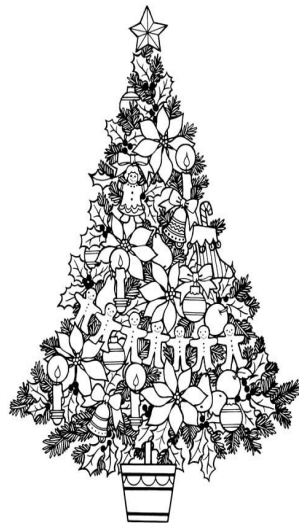


“A Stitch in Time” 19th Annual Quilt Show April 1 - May 31
