



Marty Stuart & His Fabulous Superlatives - Since starting out singing gospel as a child, the bluegrass stint with Lester Flatt in the '70s, the six years with Johnny Cash in the '80s, and coming up with his smash "hillbilly rock" hits of the '90s, the five time GRAMMY-winner, platinum recording artist, Grand Ole Opry star, country music memorabilia preservationist,
